## SING YIN SECONDARY SCHOOL

Sing Yin Secondary School was founded at 11, On Tin Street, Lam Tin in September 1970 under the sponsorship of the Divine Word Missionaries. It was built and administered by Rev. Patrick Canavan who was its Supervisor and Principal for twenty three years. Under Fr. Canavan's able leadership, Sing Yin quickly developed into a top quality school where students can receive a good, all-round education. On 1<sup>st</sup> September 2011, it moved to 38 New Clear Water Bay Road.

The Divine Word Missionaries, the sponsoring body of Sing Yin Secondary School, is an international Catholic society of priests and brothers. It was founded by a German priest, Fr. Arnold Janssen, in 1875 and China was the first mission of the society. In 1879, Fr. Joseph Freinademetz boarded a ship to Hong Kong and started his missionary work here. Fr. Arnold Janssen and Fr. Joseph Freinademetz were canonized on 5<sup>th</sup> October 2003 by Pope John Paul II. The Divine Word Missionaries has grown steadily and there are now over 6,000 priests and brothers working in more than 80 countries around the world.

Sing Yin Secondary School gets its name from the Bible. The Gospel of John opens with the words "In the beginning was the Word". This "Word" refers to the Son of God who became man in the person of Jesus Christ. For Christian, He is the Way, the Truth and the Life.

Sing Yin is a Catholic school and, following the teaching of Jesus, special emphasis is given to moral education and community service. In this way, Sing Yin aims to give its students the best possible set of values by which to live a meaningful life and, at the same time, to become true pillars of society.

### 聖言中學簡介

聖言中學於一九七零年九月於藍田安田街十一號開校，為聖言會主辦的天主教學校。聖言中學是由甘百德神父籌辦和監建的，甘神父其後更出任本校校監及校長二十三年。在他的英明領導下，聖言中學迅速發展為一所優質學校，為學生提供良好、整全的教育。本校於二零一一年九月一日遷到新清水灣道三十八號現址。

聖言會乃一個世界性的天主教修會團體。它在一八七五年由德國神父楊生安諾所創立，並先在中國從事傳道工作。一八七九年福若瑟神父來到香港開始傳教。二零零三年十月五日前任教宗若望保祿二世為聖楊生神父及聖福若瑟神父封聖。聖言會穩健地發展，現今已有六千名以上的神父及修士在八十多個國家服務。

「聖言」這個名字是源自若望福音第一章「在起初已有聖言」。「聖言」是指天主聖子降生成人，就是耶穌基督。為基督徒來說，祂就是道路、真理、生命。

作為一所天主教學校，聖言中學遵從耶穌的教導，特別注重道德教育及社區服務。本校辦學的目標，正在於扶助學生確立一套圓滿的價值觀，以活得富有意義，並且成為社會的真正棟樑。

## **School Goals**

Our goal is to prepare students to live a healthy, affluent and meaningful life. More specifically, we aim:

1. To help students to appreciate life and to develop a commitment to sustain all lives, especially human life forever. Thus environmental education should be a core goal of our education.
2. To help students consolidate the values and attitudes necessary for the development of moral character, such as: Faith, Hope, Love, Appreciation, Respect, Responsibility, Peace, Honesty, Justice, Self-discipline, Service, Co-operation, Simplicity, Courage, Perseverance, Sincerity, Tolerance, Self-Restraint and Delayed Gratification on which the sustainable development of the human race are based. These values are to be interpreted in the light of the Bible and good, traditional Chinese culture.
3. To strive to develop in our students the ability to think, judge, and act objectively and independently - that is, to be wise and rational. Critical thinking and debating skills are important, but students must know the shortcomings of these skills. On the other hand, we need to ensure that our students are sympathetic and be able to express their feelings in proper ways.
4. To enable our students to solve the problems they will face in life and societal problems, taking into consideration the pros and cons of different solutions and not be biased by advocacy opinions and other factors. The solutions adopted should be effective, efficient, fair and just.
5. To ensure that our students strive for a balance between their rights and responsibilities.
6. To guide the students towards finding meaning and purpose in their lives through an awareness of the existence of God and their obligation to serve God by developing their aptitudes in order to serve not just themselves but also to serve their fellow humans as members of God's great human family.
7. To provide for the full and proper formation of Catholic students.
8. To provide non-Christians with the opportunity of knowing about the life and teaching of Christ and to provide religious instruction for any non-Christian who freely desires it.
9. To promote respect for lawful government and its representatives, the observance of just laws, and a search for the common good which includes civic values such as freedom, social justice, and the dignity of work. Related activities should be appropriate to the developmental stages of students.
10. To vigorously promote voluntary service by the students both in and out of school.

11. To foster in our students a reverence for life in all its stages, an understanding of the significance of family life for the individual and for society, and the conditions conducive to a good family life. They should embrace filial duty, love their wives and care for their off springs.
12. To enable students to live a physically and psychologically healthy life now and after graduation.
13. To develop a challenging and comprehensive curriculum which will match the students interests and abilities and which will provide them with the knowledge, skills and attitudes which will enable them to have a better understanding of the world, become financially independent and capable of playing a positive role in the social and economic development of the community.
14. To help the students reach a good standard in both written Chinese and English, and to communicate fluently in Cantonese, Mandarin and English.
15. To provide the students with a basic knowledge of the society they live in, with special emphasis on the history and geography of China, and to cultivate in them a love of our Mother Country and Mother Earth.
16. To provide a chance for students to develop a basic appreciation of Art, Music and Chinese Literature and to foster interest in their Chinese cultural heritage.
17. To enable the students to understand the methods of Science, the influence of Science on human life, the main scientific facts, and the relationship of science to the Christian religion. We hold that science and religion are complementary rather than contradictory.
18. To develop leadership, career aspiration and personal interests of the students through extra-curricular activities.
19. To provide for the Pastoral Care of the Students with the assistance of the Social Workers and the Guidance Department.
20. To provide effective lines of communication among the administration, the staff, the parents, the students and the local community.
21. In the spirit of the Gospel to promote a pleasant, caring, family atmosphere within the school community which includes the Staff, the Students and the School administrators.

Most of these goals are further developed into two layers of sub-goals. At the fundamental layer, the spiritual, moral, cognitive, physical, social and aesthetic goals are of equal importance. At the higher layer, spiritual and moral goals come first, followed by cognitive goals. The social, physical and aesthetic sub-goals should be prioritized on an individual basis.

## **Summary Report**

The 2022-2023 school year was a year of historical significance. On 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022, our school still did not meet the vaccination requirements, we were only allowed to conduct half-day face-to-face lessons. Yet, we eventually met the requirements after October. We received the School Vaccination Commendation Scheme Gold Award and the approval from the EDB to resume whole-day face-to-face lessons starting from 1st November 2022.

On 30th May 2023, Fr. Canavan, our school founder passed away. The Requiem Mass was held in South Africa on 7th June 2023. We arranged an online mass in our school hall. Almost all our staff and some students participated. The SVD and the school held a requiem mass in St. James Church on 25th June 2023. Our Supervisor, Fr. Johnson was the celebrant. Eight other SVD priests were also invited to help. Many former staff members, current staff members and some students attended the prayer meeting. The school and the Alumni Association jointly held a prayer meeting in the school hall on 1st July 2023. Many alumni and teachers attended the prayer meeting. The school also held a prayer meeting for the all the school staff members and students on the last day of the school, 12th July 2023.

The 2023 HKDSE result was satisfactory. In extra-curricular activities, a total of 411 prizes in local and international competitions were won.

### **Academic Achievement**

In the 2023 HKDSE, the percentage of Level 4 or above was 58.6.

77.1% of our graduates were enrolled into degree programmes.

20.0% of our graduates were enrolled into associate degree or sub-degree programmes.

Altogether, 97.1% of our graduates were admitted to universities and other tertiary institutes.



### **Achievement in Extra-curricular Activities**

- Five students were qualified to represent Hong Kong to take part in the World Bridge Federation Youth Championships 2023 held in the Netherlands. They are all Form 3 students: Cai Ming Ho, Hui Hoi Hin, Chung Henderson, Kwok Yuen, and Fung Ching Ho. In the competition, they got the 10th place among 20 teams all over the world.
- Lau Yam Man (F6) represented Hong Kong to attend the 19th International Geography Olympiad held in Indonesia.

They were Anane Mawutor David, Chan Ho Fung, Ko Shaun, Kwan Tsz Hong, Ng Hei Shing, and Siu Cheuk Fung. Our English Debating Team also awarded the First Runner-up in 2022-2023 Hong Kong Secondary Schools Debating Competition. The Team members were Ng Pak Lam, Chung Ching Tin and Wong Tsz Kit from F.3.
- Fung Lap Yip and Hee Chi Him David from F.5 received the Commendable Award in the Sayings of Wisdom Motivational Talk Contest.
- Our students won the Championship in both the junior and the senior level in the 1st Hong Kong Youth Chinese Culture and Tourism Knowledge Competition.
- 4 Form Five students, Chen Qingyuan, Tam Hiu Kam, Wu Ki Yu, and Pak King Tai won the Championship in the senior secondary level (group section) in the 2nd Hong Kong Youth Chinese Culture and Tourism Knowledge Competition. Chen Qingyuan won the First Runner-up of the senior secondary level (individual section).
- Our Mathematics Team won the overall Champion in MathConception 2023. In the competition, our students got 6 gold, 4 silver and 2 bronze medals. In the Fortieth Hong Kong Mathematics Olympiad, our Team got Regional Winners Prize (Kowloon East). In Hong Kong Hua Luo-geng Cup Mathematics Competition 2023, one of our F.1 students got Gold prize. In the International Mathematical Olympiad Preliminary Selection Contest – HK 2023, our students got 1 Bronze and 1 Honourable Mention.

## **School Affairs**

The Administrative Affairs Committee was renamed as the Teachers' Affairs Committee. The role of the Committee was clearly defined. The matters discussed in the committee were well settled.

The National Security Education Committee was set up. The Principal was the Chairperson. In the staff meetings, teachers were told about the importance of national security education and how it could be implemented in the lessons. 19 teachers attended courses, seminars, and workshops on National Security Education. The total number of CPD hours was 78.5. A new Flag Pole was bought and put in the school hall in case the flag raising ceremony could not be conducted in the Open Area. Curriculum content was covered in various subjects such as Chinese Language, Science, BAFS, Geography, Religious and Moral Education etc, with a view to promoting among students a clear understanding of the importance of national security.

The Prize-Giving Ceremony Committee and the Graduation Ceremony Committee were merged to become the Ceremony Committee. The roles of the Committee were clearer and the all the ceremonies within the school year were successfully held.

On 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021, the EDB announced measures to optimize the four senior secondary core subjects. The optimizing measures were implemented in Form 4 and Form 5. Starting from 2022-2023, for both F.4 and F.5, there were 3 lessons for Citizenship and Social Development and 6 lessons for each elective subjects.

About the curriculum, the subject EPA was replaced by Life and Society in F.1 to F.3. The number of lessons allocated per cycle remained unchanged.

In 2022-2023, 3 students were allowed to join the network programmes of Music. In addition, all Form 3 students could apply for joining DSE Music and PE network programmes .

To cater for F6 students who had dropped an elective, three supply teachers were recruited to assist their learning in Chinese, English and Mathematics respectively from September to December during their free lessons of the elective dropped.

This year, one non-Chinese speaking (NCS) student was admitted in Form 1. There were two non-Chinese speaking (NCS) students in the school (one in F.1 and one in F.2) We applied the EDB's funding for Enhancing Support for Learning and Teaching Chinese for them. A tutor was also recruited to help them. However, the F.2 NCS student left school in March 2023.

Study skills courses were conducted for all forms on Saturdays. The Principal himself spent 7 Saturday mornings on teaching our students how to study. The five teachers in the study skill programme team attended the courses and they learnt how to take charge of this programme in the future. The Principal also helped to teach all the F.1 students who were admitted to the school for 2023-2024 in the summer programme in July and August.

284 primary students applied for the discretionary places. As the Government capped the cohort size at 170, we were allowed to offer only 51 discretionary places. Through central allocation, 109 students were assigned to the school.

The total number of teaching staff establishment was 64. With the Capacity Enhancement Grant, we employed 1 contract teacher and 2 teaching assistants in the school year. With the Learning Support Grant, we employed one more teaching assistant for the SEN support. With the Administration Grant and Teachers' Relief Grant, we employed two more teaching assistants for Pastoral Ministry and the library service respectively.

To provide a better learning environment for our students, our school campus was improved. For campus security, some metal rails were installed above the entrance gates to avoid outsiders from climbing over the gates in illegal trespass. The school applied to the EDB for funding on major repairs, including repainting the outer walls of the buildings. In the Staff Common Room, the television was mounted on the wall and two dining tables were bought to increase the capacity for teachers to have lunch. Storage space in Staffroom, Annex Staff Room, and Staff Common Room was increased. The internet switches were upgraded so that they could provide electricity to the IP phones. A retractable awning was installed at the balcony outside Staff Common Room. A new aqua farm was installed on the G/F near the organic farm for education purpose. Two pianos were placed in the campus to allow students to play during the recesses, lunchtime and after school. The Janitor room was moved from the 2/F to the G/F for better communication. The Janitor room on the 2/F was used by the PTA and the Alumni Association. A TV display was installed under the main staircase to display information of school events. The Herb Garden on the 4/F was renovated. The Pond of Benevolence and Garden of Benevolence were set up and named by our donor Dr. Wong Chun Wa, and the Naming Ceremony was held on Graduation Day.

By the end of the school year, 1 teacher retired and 9 teachers including the NET resigned from school.

## **Report on School's Major Concerns**

There were three major concerns for the 2022-2023 school year.

### **1. To help students to learn and develop the core Catholic Values**

- In 2021-2022, the school arranged activities for students to learn the 5 core values of Catholic Education, namely Truth, Justice, Love, Life and Family. In 2022-2023, the school further assisted the students to learn and develop these values.
- The school took part in the 'Jockey Club Volunteer Together Project'. This was a citywide programme initiated and funded by The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust to promote volunteerism in Hong Kong. In collaboration with 12 partner organizations, this Project strived to develop technology-enabled, innovative volunteer engagement models with targeted programmes to encourage and mobilize students to do good for the community. In our school, the Community Services Department, Catholic Education Committee, and Religious and Moral Education Department cooperated and joined this project to help our students to develop the values of 'Love' through voluntary services.
- The Life Education programme continuously helped the F.1-F.2 students in knowing the meaning of 'Life' and the programme nurtured their good personality. The students had the opportunity to appreciate the nature, know more about themselves, realize their personal limitations, and learn how to interact with other people and care about others.
- The Catholic Education Committee promoted the core values of 'Life', 'Love' and 'Family' through activities, especially in the Religious Week which was held from 10<sup>th</sup> May to 15<sup>th</sup> May 2023. In the Religious Week, more than ten activities were conducted through the co-operation and collaboration among different committees and departments including Catholic Education Committee, Religious and Moral Education Department, Chinese Language and English Language Department, Music Department, Reading Across the Curriculum Committee and the Parent-Teacher Association. The theme was 'Love and Family'. The activities included the Religious Talk, Quiz, Book Display, Flower handicraft celebrating Mother's Day, Board Display, Music Appreciation and Voluntary work. Religious Week was successfully completed and was the best Religious Week in Sing Yin ever seen.
- We invited many guests to deliver the messages of the core Catholic values. They included Fr. Paulus Budi Kleden, SVD, Superior General of SVD, Fr. Kam Po Wai, the Vicar General of Hong Kong, Fr. Balubun Anthonius Reynolds, SVD, Rev. Flandez Jay Francis Roa, SVD, our SVD Managers, and Mr. Kung Kwong Pui, Episcopal Delegate for Education of Catholic Board of Education.
- The RME Department joined the programme with Ebenezer School & Home for the Visually Impaired to let F.3 students develop empathy upon people.

- The Reading Across the Curriculum Committee arranged sharing on books related to the core catholic values. The Principal gave a book sharing in the morning assembly in September to illustrate the importance of ‘Love and Care’. Besides, the book reviews on related themes were collected and posted on the electronic signage, website, and social media of the library throughout the whole year. A book exhibition on Catholic Values provided by the Catholic Centre was held at the library during the Religious Week in May 2023.
- History Department joined an experiential activity called ‘Warzone 90” organised by the Red Cross Hong Kong in December. The activity aimed to guide students to experience the taste of despair, as well as the glimpse of hope when faced with a war. Students reacted positively and reinforced their major Catholic values of ‘Life and Truth’.
- Guidance Department organized and joined the activities organized by outside bodies to help delivering the messages of ‘Love, Life and Family’. The activities included ‘Soft Meal Workshop’, ‘Visit to the elderly and Dementia patients’, the ‘MAGIC’ programme,
- The Principal delivered the messages of the 5 core Catholic values to all the students in the sharing sessions during the morning assemblies. Last year, there were 12 sharing sessions. Furthermore, he organized 3 parents’ talks on the following themes: effective parenting, 5 core Catholic values, and how to improve students’ self-discipline.

## **2. To foster students’ reading habit**

- Different Departments organized reading programmes to promote students’ reading habit, e.g., BAFS, CSD, Biology, Chemistry, English, and Chinese etc. The students read related magazine, eBook, and newspaper to extend their reading. For example, the CSD joined the online learning platform held by the Academy of Chinese Studies.
- English Department continued to organize the ‘Book of My Choice’ scheme to promote reading. Extensive Reading Scheme was conducted as usual for F.1-F.5.
- The Reading Across the Curriculum Committee was set up last year. Its role was to promote reading habits. The Morning Reading Programme was organized for the first time. It was held every Wednesday morning to foster the reading habit. Articles were organized into two reading booklets to cater for the diverse levels of students. Students showed positive feedback to the diversity of articles provided by different Departments. Evaluation was done and the feedback was positive and encouraging.
- The school applied funding from the Jockey Club to promote online reading. Three e-reading platforms were subscribed.
- To lessen the workload of the Teacher-Librarian, a teaching assistant was hired to assist in the library services. Besides, the school had applied for QEF funding to improve the library facilities.

- Some theme-based activities were held to promote reading across the curriculum. These programmes enhanced the culture of collaboration among teachers in promoting reading.
- Activities of the joint school reading club were organized. The joint school reading club, together with St Paul's School (Lam Tin) and Leung Shek Chee College, organized a joint-school reading activity. The book read was “Cathedral” written by Raymond Carver.
- Chinese History and History Department participated in Junior Secondary History e-Reading Award Scheme.
- Magazines were provided in the 2/F leisure space and it was observed that some students were interested in reading them. Selected class libraries were reinforced to create a better reading culture inside classrooms and it was observed that students read casually at leisure.
- All F.1 students could enjoy extensive reading in 1 period per cycle in Chinese Language lesson. More than 10 sessions of after-class reading group meetings were held so that each F1 student had joined at least one in the year. The discussions among students showed positive feedback.
- The library had organised the Library Reading Award Scheme with the English Department and the Chinese Department. The scheme was divided into two parts. The first part was held from November to December 2022 whereas the second part was from March to April 2023. The participants who had taken part in the reading award scheme could enter this record into the Challenge Programme.
- Visits to the Central Library were organised for F.1 Students from 20th Nov (Red House), 27th Nov (Yellow House), 4th Dec (Blue House), and 11th Dec (Green House) by the Extra-Curricular Activities Department, Reading across the Curriculum Committee, and the library. A reading booklet was designed for students, which included precautions in using the library service, reading habit survey, book review, mini mission, and library activities to let them explore more in the visit.
- New F.1 students were brought to the library to learn about some basic functions and rules of the library from 25th July 2023 to 31st July 2023. The eBooks was chosen in the eRead scheme in HK Reading city in EdCity. The students handed in a book report as an assignment during the summer holiday.

### 3. To enhance professional development of teachers

- Peer lessons observation and professional sharing between teachers were conducted in almost all Departments to increase teaching competence. Teachers’ sharing meetings were also held.
- With the help of the IT Department, the eClass integrated platform, Grwth App, Microsoft 365, and Google Workspace were introduced so that the teachers could use them to teach the students more effectively.



- In the Staff Development Programme, we organized Team Building Programme on Staff Development Day. Teachers were divided into groups and worked together as a team to promote sense of belonging to the school, strengthen teamwork and foster positive relationships among colleagues.
- The Principal shared information and his experience to teachers about the External School Review and how to conduct a good lesson.
- To promote teachers' professionalism, two in-house professional workshops were organized. The first one was held on 11 November 2022 on the topic of "Teaching Writing" by Ms. Suzi Nicholson. The second one was conducted on 9 March 2023 by Ms. Diana Bruce on the topic of "The World of a Voice Artist". Teachers gave positive feedback about the workshops and gained a lot of knowledge on the respective areas.
- During Department meetings, members shared materials and experiences they gained from taking part in training courses, talks, and seminars from EDB, universities and other institutions. As regards conducting lessons on Zoom, teachers shared their experiences using different platforms and functions such as Explain Everything, Nearpod, breakout rooms, whiteboards, Google shared drive and Microsoft OneNote, etc.
- Chinese Language Department invited one Assistant Principal from C.C.C. Mong Man Wai College and two Panel Heads from Hong Kong Wah Yan College to share their teaching experiences. Physics Department had a chance to share with the Panel Heads from St. Paul Secondary School (Lam Tin).
- In the Teachers' Professional Training Programme, teachers spent two half-days to learn more about cyber-bullying and sexual violence in schools. This was conducted by the Caritas Youth and Community Service. Talks, discussions, and interactive sessions helped equip teachers with the necessary skills to face and handle relevant incidents, thereby providing support to students.
- Our school was the only one Environmental Demonstration School in Hong Kong. To raise the environmental awareness of our teachers, workshop on recycling and waste separation was held on 25<sup>th</sup> May 2023. Teachers were divided into groups to take part in different upcycling workshops. This activity aligned with our commitment to promoting environmental conversation and raising awareness among students.
- To assist our teachers and non-teaching staff to learn more about the core Catholic values, our teachers, teaching assistants and laboratory technicians attended the Catholic School Teachers' Day 2023 held on 25th May 2023 at the Asia World-Expo.

## **School Management and Staff Consultation**

In the 2022-2023 school year, the school was managed, administered and operated by the Incorporated Management Committee in accordance to the Constitution laid down by the IMC which shall comply with the Education Ordinance and the code of aid for secondary schools.

The IMC was composed of 8 SVD managers appointed by the Sponsoring Body, 1 parent manager and 1 alternate parent manager, 1 teacher manager and 1 alternate teacher manager, 1 alumni manager and 1 independent manager.

The registered SVD Managers were Rev. Johnson Dhos, Supervisor and the Chairperson of the IMC, Rev. Flandez Jay Roa, Rev. Venus Arjay Apinado, Rev. John Baptist Le Van Ba, Rev. Hadiarto Heribertus, Rev. Balubun Anthonius Reynolds, Rev. Mullackal Chakkappan Manoj, and Rev. Paul ZhongXue Chen was the Alternate SVD Manager.

The Teacher Manager was Ms. Yang Ka Wah and the Alternate Teacher Manager was Mr. Hui Chi Kuen.

The Parent Manager was Ms. Yung Wai Lan and the Alternate Parent Manager was Ms. Ho Sum Yue.

The Alumni Manager was Mr. Lee Pui Keung and the Independent Manager was Ms. Fan Lai Mei.

The Honorary Manager was Rev. John Zhang Xinghao.

Mrs. Kwok Cheng Mei Ling and Mr. Yung Lit Hung, the Vice Principals, attended IMC meetings by invitation.

Our school's administrative arrangements emphasize staff consultation. There were three consultative committees: the Academic Affairs Committee, the Student Support Committee and the Teachers' Affairs Committee to discuss matters related to academic affairs, student affairs and staff welfare respectively. These three committees aimed at providing optimal opportunity for consultation between the principal and the teaching staff. Besides, staff meetings were held about four times per school year. Apart from reporting, these meetings also aimed to collect the opinion of teachers. After consultation, sometimes decisions were made by the principal. For important matters, the final decision was made by the IMC.

Routine decisions were made by the Principal and the Executive Committee. This committee, comprising the Principal and the three Vice Principals met about once a week.

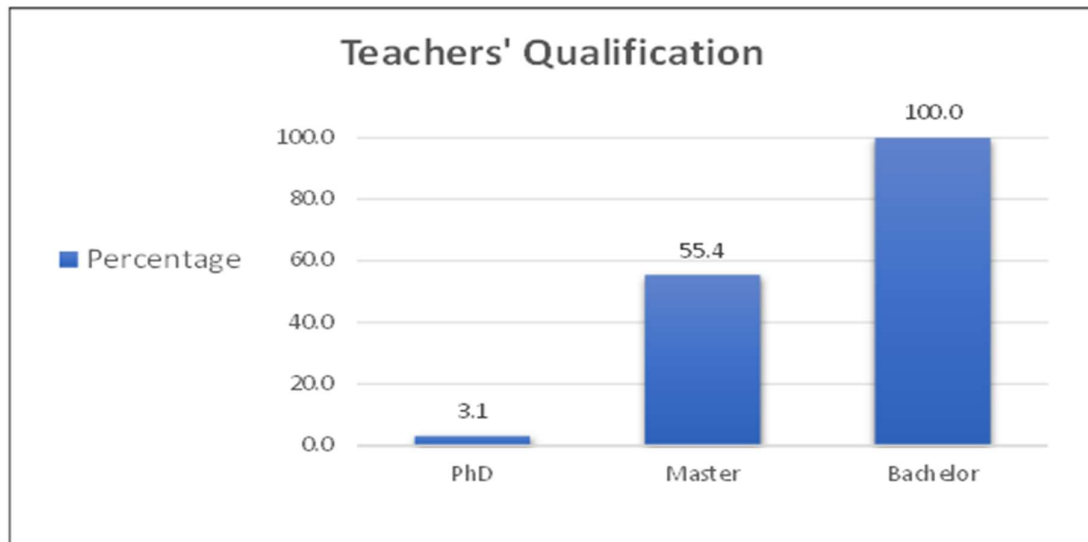
## Staff Profile

### a. Teachers' Establishment

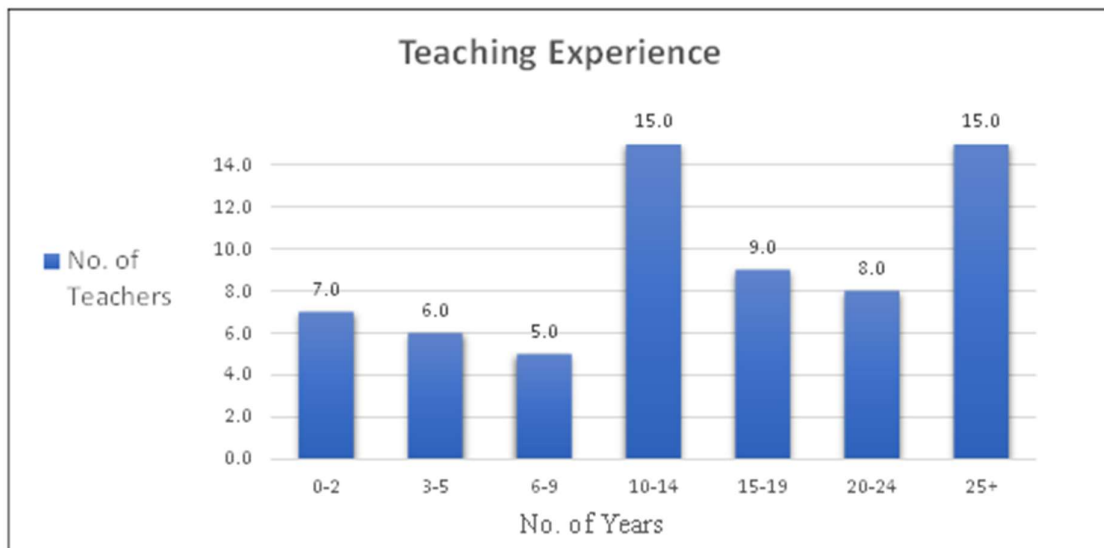
The number of teachers stood at 65. There were 34 male teachers and 31 female teachers. One of them was an English native-speaker. In addition, there were 4 technicians, 6 office staff members, 12 janitors and 6 teaching assistants. Among the teachers, 15 were Catholics.

### b. Teachers' Qualification

Of the 65 teachers, all of them had a bachelor degree, 2 had doctoral degrees, 36 had a master degree, 62 had received professional training, 47 had more than 10 years of teaching experience. All our English and Chinese teachers were subject trained.

d. Teachers' Continuing Professional Development Report

This year, teachers spent a total of 3461 hours on continuing professional development, averaging 54.09 hours per teacher.

Three staff development days were held. The First Staff Development Day was held on 16th November 2022. It commenced with a morning session consisting of two workshops. Our Principal, Mr. Wong, shared his experiences of conducting the External School Review (ESR). This workshop equipped teachers with the necessary knowledge and resources to prepare for the review effectively. It was followed by the Language Across the Curriculum (LAC) Workshop, emphasizing the importance of integrating language skills into various subject areas. In the afternoon, a Team Building Workshop was conducted to strengthen teamwork and foster positive relationships among colleagues.

The Second Staff Development Day began with a workshop on the prevention and handling of cyber-bullying and sexual violence in schools conducted by the Caritas Youth and Community Service on 10th March 2023. Talks, discussions, and interactive sessions helped equip teachers with the necessary skills to face and handle relevant incidents, thereby providing support to students. In the afternoon, we had the opportunity to visit the Hong Kong Palace Museum.

The Third Staff meeting started with a workshop on recycling and waste separation on 25th May 2023. Teachers were divided into groups to take part in different upcycling workshops. This activity aligns with our commitment to promoting environmental conversation and raising awareness among students. In the afternoon, our teachers attended the Catholic School Teachers' Day 2023 held at the Asia World-Expo.

As indicated by the results of online survey with teachers, it was unanimously agreed by the respondents that the aforementioned development programmes were conducted in a well-organised fashion, achieved their intended objectives, and proved useful and inspiring. Furthermore, over 95% of teachers expressed satisfaction with the overall arrangement of the development programmes and found the information obtained thus applicable to their work.

## Student Profile

### a. General

On 1 September 2022, the student enrolment was 946, with 168, 167, 159, 152, 144 and 156 in F1 to F6 respectively. One of the reasons for the decrease of students was the students' withdrawal from school. 21 students withdrew during the school year.

About 77% lived in Kwun Tong District. 8% students are Catholics while most students did not have any religion. The median family monthly income was \$25,515.

### b. Reading Habit

The Library has established a computerised system and students can renew, reserve and search for information of the library titles at home. The total number of book checkouts was 2496 this school year and the monthly average issue rate was 208.

A total of 1,391 books of the English Extensive Reading Scheme and 1,285 books of the Chinese Extensive Reading Scheme have been shelved and cataloged in the Library. The total number of book checkouts for English ERS was 91 and that for the Chinese ERS was 145. The monthly loan rate of these kinds of materials was 20 this year. Some language

teachers would bring students to the Library to borrow books of these two schemes during their lessons. This has allowed students more time to choose books and could increase the number of book checkouts.

The class size in Form 1 has to be reduced according to EDB's regulation. This year the class size was 34.

All the allocated Form 1 students are basically in Band 1. Some of the students who were weaker in English and Chinese would be allocated in Form 1A. Double manning was adopted in the English and Chinese Language lessons. There is no streaming policy for Form 2 and 3. All the 5 classes in each Form 2 and 3 are more or less of the same academic standard.

Streaming starts in Form 4 and students are allocated into 5 classes according to their preferences and their academic standards. Form 4 students have to study 4 core subjects – English, Chinese, Maths and Citizenship and Social Development and 3 electives.

## Curriculum

The design of our curriculum centers on our mission - to enable students to live a full life; a life that is healthy, affluent and meaningful.

To live a meaningful life, one must have proper values. In Sing Yin, we treasure Christian and good Chinese values the most. Consequently, we allocate two lessons per cycle throughout the 6 years of schooling on moral and civic education. These are supported by many other programs and activities outside of lesson hours.

Apart from moral development, we aim to provide a broad education through a balance of subjects. There is a balanced curriculum in academic and cultural subjects. Furthermore, a great variety of options of academic subjects are offered to our Form 4 to Form 6 students.

### **a. Religious and Moral Education**

From the time it was founded in 1970, our school has always emphasized the moral development of our students through both formal and informal means. Moral Education is formally taught, with two periods per cycle, in all classes, from Form 1 to Form 6. In the mid-90s' with the approach of Hong Kong's return to China, Civic Education is incorporated with the objective of helping students to better understand and know our country. A range of activities is organized to foster moral development and civic duties of the students. These include Morning Reflection, weekly prayers, talks, visits and community services. Please refer to the departmental report for more details.

It is through formal teaching and various activities that help our students to develop into citizens who love themselves and their neighbour, set their eyes on the district, help build Hong Kong, care about their Mother land and embrace the world.

Our school aims to expand the horizon of our students' spirituality, to introduce them to Christian principles, values and beliefs and to help them find the meaning of life.

To develop our students' spirituality, we introduce our students to the Catholic faith and Christian beliefs through formal scheduled lessons, in which they have a chance to reflect and judge if these are worthwhile for themselves.

At the same time we try to deepen our Catholic students' faith and to introduce the joy brought forth by the Gospel to them through various religious activities.

Special programmes are organized for Catholic students every Tuesday afternoon to foster their faith. The Catholic Society also arranges retreat, Way of the Cross, visits and community service for its members. Other activities during the year may include: Prayer Service for the new school year; morning mass for F1 to F5 students; visit and caroling in "Home for the Aged"; and lessons for students interested in the Catholic faith.

The workload for catholic teachers is great. We employed a teaching assistant to help with the catholic activities. Rev. John Zhang Xinghao, S.V.D. was also kind to join us as a teacher for Religious and Moral Education since 2011. He was now the Head of RME Department.



## b. Period Allocation For Subjects

The timetable is made up of a 6-day cycle consisting 48 periods. F4 to F6 students have 4 core subjects and 3 electives.

**e. Medium of Instruction**

Our school aims at trilingualism in English, Cantonese and Putonghua, and biliteracy in English and Chinese for all students. Of course the proficiency level expected for each of these languages differs. In spoken language, we expect students to speak excellent Cantonese, fluent English and reasonable Putonghua. In written language, we expect them to write excellent Chinese and English.

English is adopted as the medium of instruction for all subjects other than Putonghua and Chinese subjects, P.E., Visual Art, and RME. An English Teacher was appointed as the Chairperson of the the English Language Across the Curriculum (LAC) Committee. Since 1999, a native-speaking English teacher (NET) has been employed to give additional support to other teachers and our students. Usually, during the summer holiday, a short English programme is organized for new Form 1 students. This year, the Summer English Programme was conducted by three native instructors from Headstart Education during 25-28 July 2023.

In 2010, the EDB announced the new policy “Fine-tuning of MOI”. However, we were not affected at all. Our present MOI is the same as before, that is, English is our major medium of instruction for all classes. Analysis revealed that our students’ academic achievement is not compromised.

## **Extra-curricular Activities**

A wide range of activities is organized outside regular school hours. They provide students the opportunity to discover their interests and their creativity, discover their potential, develop their leadership qualities and improve their communication skills. All students are benefited by taking part in good leisure activities which will help them to be physically and psychologically healthy, and refraining from bad pastimes.

Through participation in extra-curricular activities, we aim at enhancing a sense of belonging and brotherhood of Sing Yin boys through horizontal and vertical integration of both teachers and students. Hence there is nothing “extra” about extra-curricular activities. Sing Yin looks upon these activities as an integral part of the education we offer. Students are expected to treat the activities just like formal lessons. For example, once they sign up for an activity, they have the duty to attend it. If necessary, they have to follow the procedures for asking for leaves.

Students are free to join the clubs. They are expected to be a member of at least one club and remain active members throughout the school year. F.1 to F.5 students should devote more time on ECA. They are encouraged to join one club for a number of years to deepen their knowledge and skill in a particular area that interests them the most. They should also join other clubs for a year or so to broaden their interests. F.6 students should put their focus back on their study, joining one club is an appropriate balance.

The Students' Association was set up in the mid-70s' and has since been playing a very active role in the school. Its executive committee is elected by students. Apart from serving as a bridge between the students and the school by reflecting students' opinion and making suggestions for the welfare of the students, it also provides services and organizes many activities such as the sale of stationary, subscription and distribution of newspaper, blood donation, and many others.

There were 59 ECA clubs to cater for different interests of students. The academic clubs provide opportunities for students to gain knowledge and experience to supplement the formal curriculum. The interest clubs provides chances for students to take part in inter-school competitions, to participate in outdoor activities, visits and outdoor training and fund-raising activities. The Catholic Society organizes weekly Catholic lessons and religious activities for the faith formation of Catholic students, guide students to discover Christian values and beliefs; and to enhance their spiritual and moral development. The Community Service Group organizes activities for the community. Through these real life experiences, our students are enriched with the best possible set of values by which to live a meaningful life. The Sing Yin Pioneers, the Catholic Society, Scouts, the Student Association also organize community service programmes.

There are post-exam activities for F1- F5 students. The activity programme is organized after the final exam in early July. The activities include talks on topics of interest, cultural performance, quizzes, singing contest, sports games, visits and field trips, etc. In the 59 ECA clubs, there were 2311 members. On average, each student joined 2.50 clubs. The total club expenditure was \$44,748.23. Please note that the total expenditure excluded the costs/fees of training courses, which were much higher than these expenses.

### Support For Students

Sing Yin adopts a whole school approach to support students. Every staff member- teachers, office staff, teaching assistants, and janitors are there to help our students. Students are also encouraged to help fellow schoolmates. Students in need can approach any staff member or suitable fellow students for help. Of course, there are times when professional help should be provided. In these cases, students will be referred to our school social workers.

For daily life problems, students can approach fellow students for help. Our Sing Yin Pioneers, Prefects, Student Association and Club officials are all there to help. Of course, Class Teacher and subject teachers are there to help too.

Any student who wishes to talk over personal problem is encouraged to do so with his Class Teacher. However, if the student should, for any reason, prefer to talk to someone other than his Class Teacher, he may approach his subject teachers or a member of the departments listed below.

- a. Guidance Department - it aims to help students develop positive self-concepts, achieve personal growth and interpersonal skills, and realize their own potential to the full. A team of counseling teachers, together with the social worker, organize and conduct both preventive and developmental programmes for the students to achieve these objectives. The programmes include personal growth groups, peer tutoring groups, leadership training programmes and orientation programmes. The Department also organizes Parents' Day to promote better communication between school and parents. All along the school adopts the "Whole School Approach to Guidance" to provide better service to the students.

- b. Careers Department - it aims to prepare students to make sound decisions on further education and career opportunities. Through visits to organizations and exhibitions, talks, seminars, information on education, employment and training opportunities is disseminated to assist students in making the right choice.
- c. Discipline Department - it aims to ensure good manners and good order in each classroom and throughout the school, to foster a healthy school culture in which effective teaching and learning can take place. Students are encouraged to develop self-discipline, to respect the rights and property of others and to attain a high standard of behaviour. They shall be responsible for their own behaviour and breaches of school rules may incur some penalty. However punishment will be accompanied by efforts to teach students the appropriate behaviour so that they can learn to be self-disciplined. As a preventive measure our school is adopting the Whole School Approach to Guidance and Discipline whereby all teachers participate actively in assisting students to resolve their problems. Students who suffer from discipline problems can approach any teachers for help. If necessary, they will be referred to discipline team members.
- d. Health & Safety Department  
We also have a team of teachers to provide guidance on health related problems. They give advice students on physical health, mental health and fitness issues.
- e. Financial Support to students  
Besides emotional support, we also offer financial support to our students. Using government funds, donated funds or our own funds, we offer financial subsidy for needy students to support their extra-curricular activities organized by Sing Yin, including training courses, study tours and graduate dinners. In particular, in the 2022-23 school year, \$59,760.00 from the School-based After-school Learning and Support Programme was used to subsidize 46 needy students. The \$58,645.00 from the Student Activities Support Grant helped subsidize 55 students. Their personal and social development and community involvement improved moderately.

## **Students' Performance**

### **a. Students' Service**

Students have the opportunity to take up voluntary social service through the Community Service Group, Community Youth Club, Sing Yin Pioneers, Catholic Society and Boy Scouts. Other organizations also contribute. Moreover, students have abundant chances to serve their fellow schoolmates in school.

This year, through the five groups mentioned above and programmes run by the Community Services Department, our students provided 39162 hours of social service in this school year, with an average of 41.4 hours per person. The service hour exceeded the standard of 2000 hours set by the Heart to Heart Programme organized by the Hong Kong Federation of Youth, which we joined in 2006.

On the Dress Casual Day (28/10/2022), the Students' Association raised a total amount of \$9560.7. The Blood Donation Day originally scheduled on 28/11/2022 was cancelled finally due to the low participation rate.

### **b. Students' Discipline**

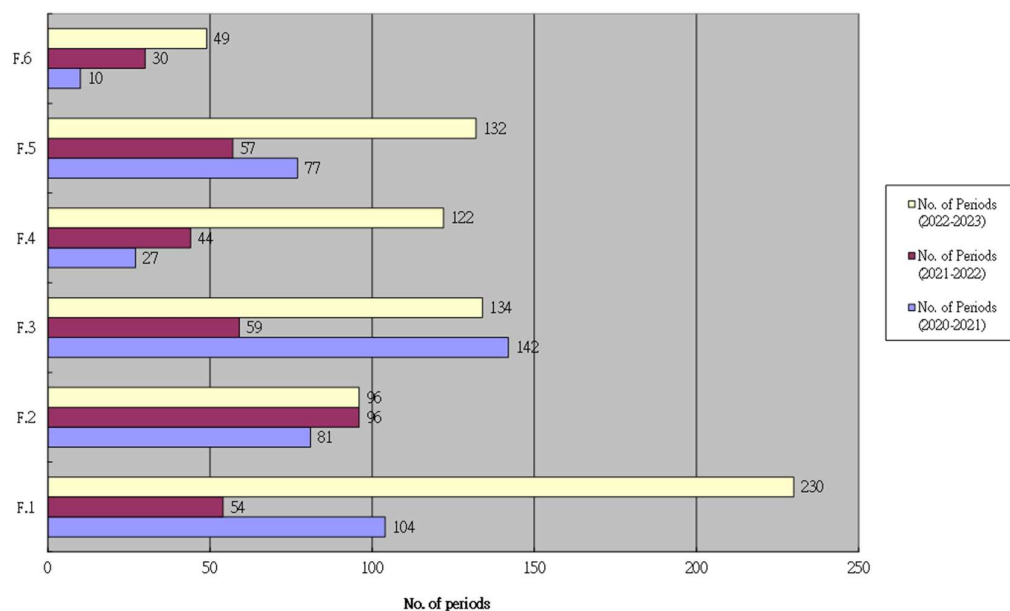
This year, the Discipline Department held a meeting with new teachers, a meeting with class teachers, a talk for F.1 on F.1 Orientation Day, discipline talks for all students and some other activities to develop self-discipline and self-control of our students, and help maintain a harmonious and safe place.

Through these efforts and all our teachers' efforts, our students behaved very well. Their attendance rates and punctuality rates stood above 98% and 99% respectively.

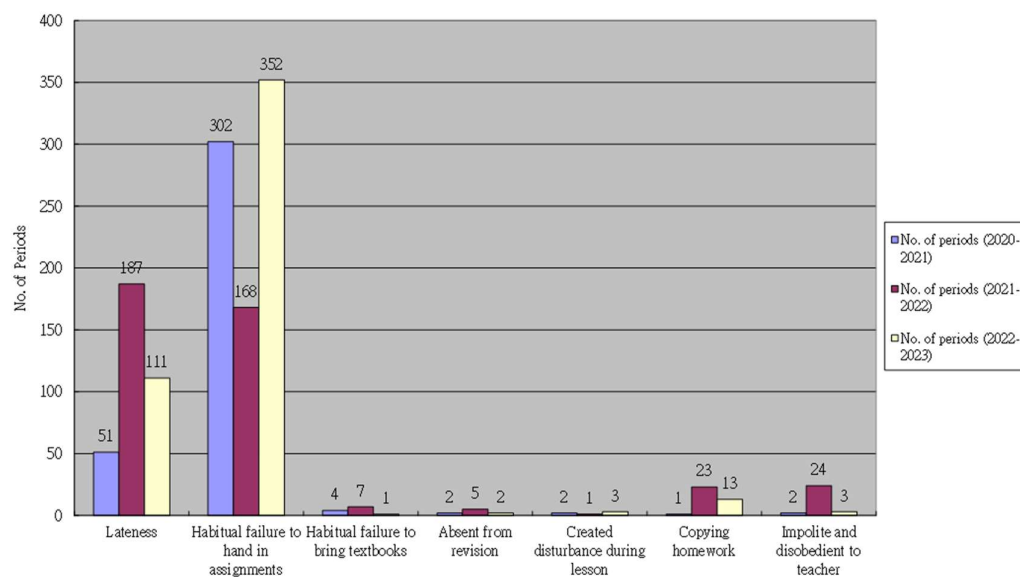
The number of suspension from lessons was 11 and detention periods on Saturdays was 763. 46.1% of the offending students were detained because they failed to hand in their assignments habitually.



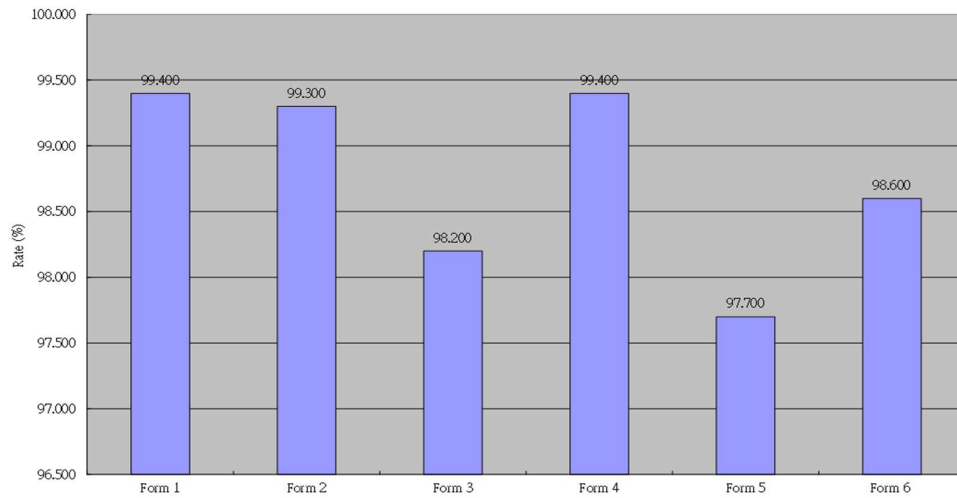
Distribution of the detention periods on Saturdays (2020-2023)



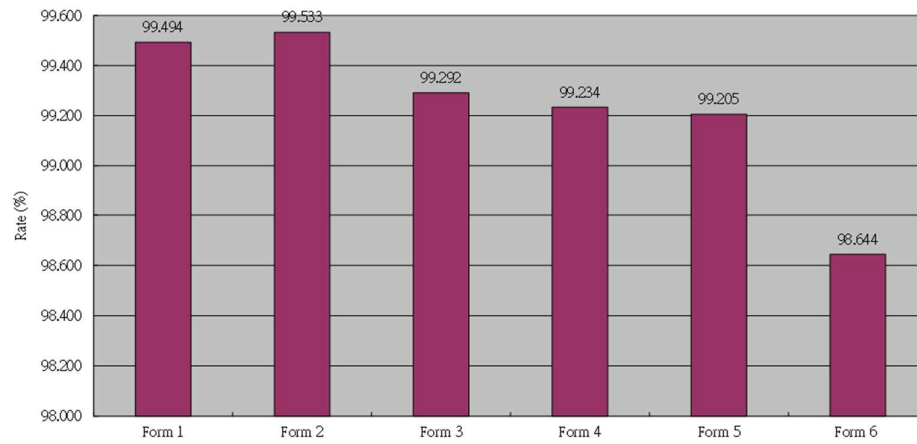
Common Reasons of the Students to have periods of Detention (2020-2023)



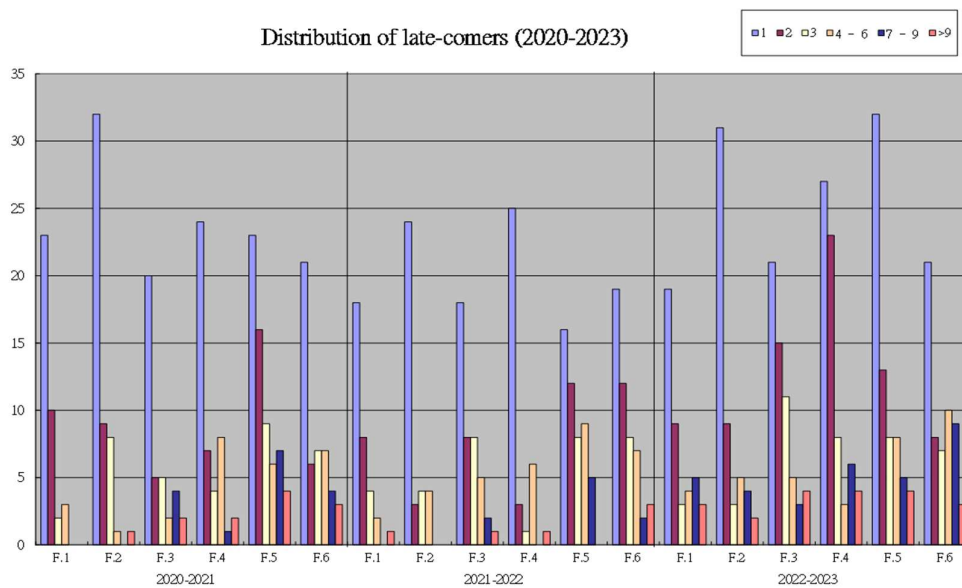
### Attendance Rate of Student in 2022-2023



### Punctuality Rate of Student in 2022-23



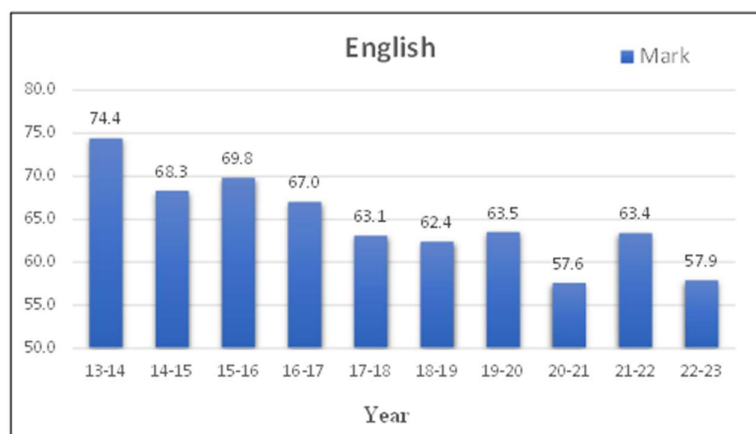
### Distribution of late-comers (2020-2023)
